



Terms & Conditions

General rules.

1. The classes are run according to the programme and format approved by "Indigo Mental Training Club" and are designed for children aged 6 to 14 years. The groups consist of 3 - 5 students.
2. The children outside of the age group indicated above are accepted solely at the discretion of administration Indigo Mental Club Training.
3. The Parent/Guardian can familiarise themselves with the format and programme during the trial lesson.
4. The Student can only use the teaching materials provided by the program. The purchase of educational materials is compulsory.

Subscription types, prices and payment terms

1. "Indigo Mental Training Club" operates a subscription system of payment for classes.
2. Monthly subscription includes:
 - a. Access to "Indigo Mental Training Club" online platform for one calendar month
 - b. 4 online lessons per calendar month, with a tutor (1 hour lesson per week)
 - c. 5 days a week of homework (no homework on the day of the lesson).
 - d. motivational system for children (branded gifts)
3. Pricing (*unless indicated differently in "Fee (per child) condition"*)
 - a. The price of the TRIAL lesson is £0.
 - b. 1 month subscription is £ 100
 - c. Sibling discount – 10% to **monthly** subscription only. Not applicable to promotional rates.
 - d. Price of training materials:
 - i. Option 1: one off payment of £60 (*it includes registration fee, abacus, workbook "Rules", Part 1, Part 2, Part 3, Part 4*). Postage to UK address is included
 - ii. Option 2: paid in 2 instalments
 - 35 £ (*registration fee, abacus, workbooks "Rules", Part 1*). Postage to UK address is included
 - 35£ (*workbooks Part 2, Part 3, Part 4*). Postage to UK address is included
4. Payment shall be made before the start of each month, on before the 1st day of classes every 4 weeks
5. Subscription payments are non-refundable and non-exchangeable. The lessons and the platform will be available for the entire subscription period, even if the Student decides to terminate the training.

Attendance, absence and late arrivals

1. Should the Student not be able to attend the class due to a family emergency or sickness, the Parent/Guardian must inform the tutor 6 hours before the class.
2. Providing the condition above has been met, the Tutor will provide a video of the topic that was missed or new date and time for the missed lesson either within an alternative, suitable group or arrange 1:1 class, which will be 20-30 minutes long (at the discretion of the tutor). The date and time to be agreed separately with the Parent/Guardian.
3. The Student's absence to be reported by call or text tutor.

4. No adjustment to fees shall be made for time lost because of late arrival by the Student or by early termination of session by the Student. Any lost time because of the late arrival of the Tutor shall be compensated for by extending a lesson by mutual agreement and by such amount of time that was lost.
5. Parents can only be present at the trial lesson, or at Tutor's discretion if the class is 1:1 format.

Obligations of the Tutor

1. The Tutor shall register the student within 24 hrs after the receipt of the payment.
2. The Tutor undertakes to do all preparation prior to lessons and to structure lessons in such a way as to optimise time to the benefit of the Student.
3. The Tutor shall keep confidential all information of the Student and shall only contact other parties involved in the education of the Student
4. The Tutor shall not assign any of his/her duties or obligations under this tutoring contract to a third party without the written permission of the Student.
5. The Tutor shall at no time be required or obliged to execute homework or assignments on behalf of the Student.

Obligations of the Student

1. The Student must have use of a laptop/pc with a working camera and microphone for the online lessons.
2. The Student must be provided with a quiet place, with no distractions for the online lessons
3. The Student must speak and behave respectfully towards the Tutor and other Students
4. The Student agrees to complete any homework or classwork assignments set by the Tutor in a timely manner as agreed prior to the task being set.

No warranties

The tutor and the Indigo Mental Training Club's administration does not give any warranties as to the student's performance and progress in case the student does not fulfill his/her obligations (meaning completing homework given by the tutor on the platform and in the textbook).
